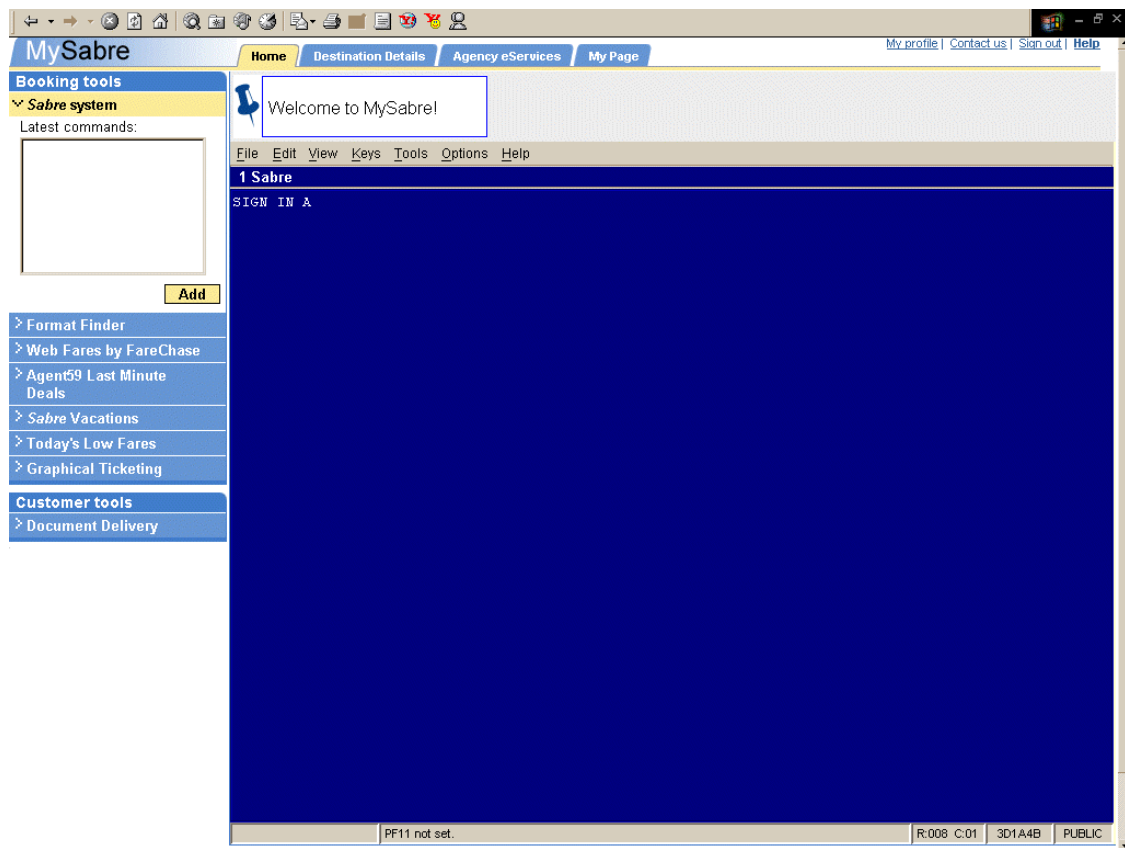


Here are some tricks you can try to maximize your internet browser fonts and screen size. These examples are for Windows 2000. Instructions for other versions of Windows may vary slightly.

Maximize your screen

While on the *MySabre* home page click on “View” in your browser menu, then click “Full Screen”. Your screen will maximize and your Windows task bar will be hidden. Simply drag your mouse to the bottom of your page and your task bar will reappear.

To exit the full screen mode, simply repeat the process. If you do not see your browser menu bar (like the example below), right click in the gray area of the task bar and select “Menu Bar”. Now you are able to click “View” and “Full Screen”. This will return your browser to it’s original size.

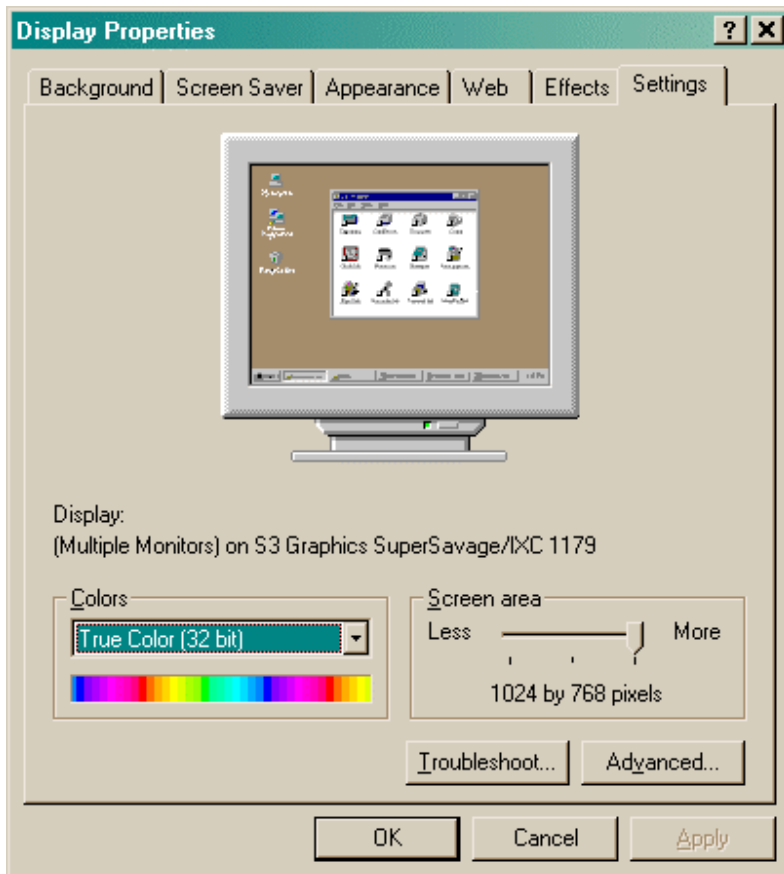


Larger Fonts for your browser:

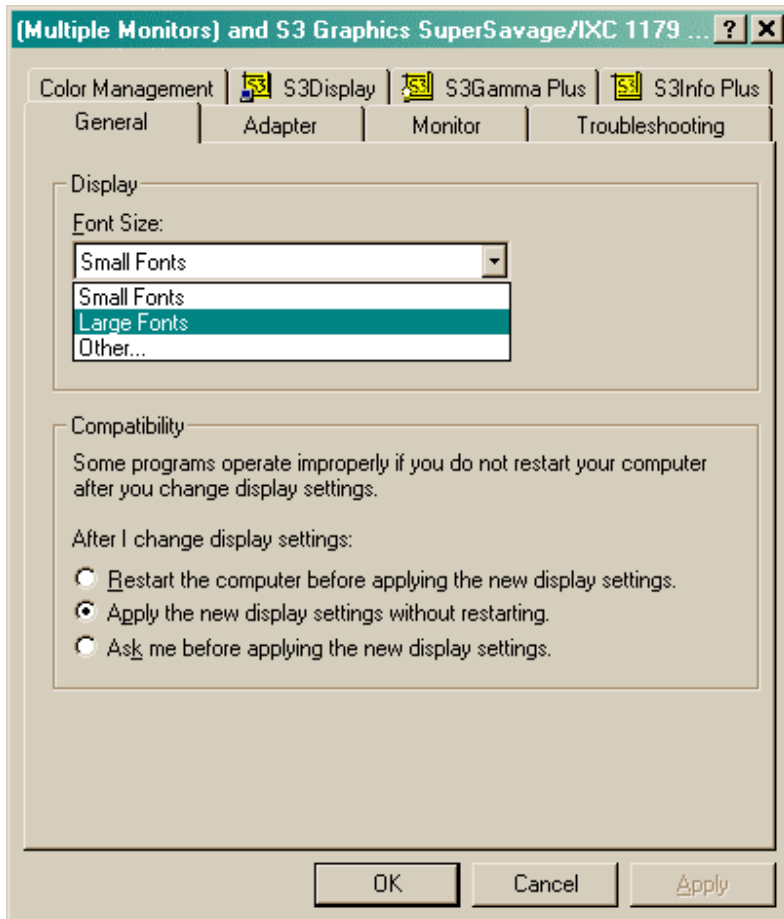
1. Click “View” in your browser menu
2. Click “Text Size”
3. Choose “Larger”

Larger Fonts system wide:

1. Click “Start”
2. Click “Settings”
3. Click “Control Panel”
4. Click “Display”
5. Click the “Settings” tab

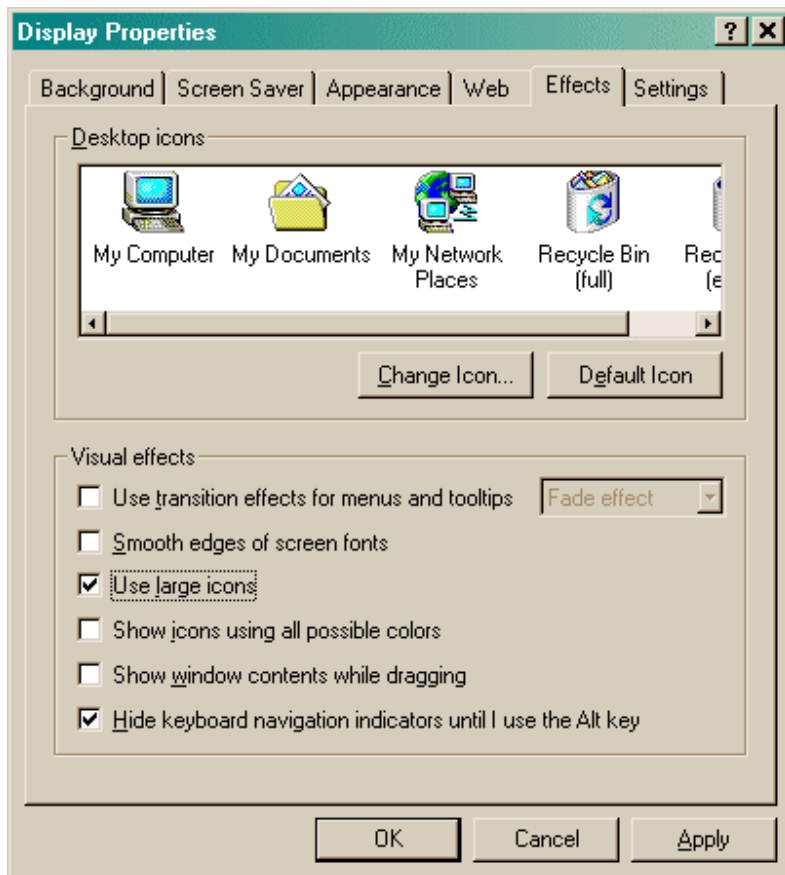


6. Click “Advanced”
7. Click the “General” tab
8. Select “Large fonts”



Larger Icons

1. Click “Start”
2. Click “Settings”
3. Click “Control Panel”
4. Click “Display”
5. Click the “Effects” tab
6. Click a check mark beside “Use Large Icons”



You can also choose to ignore font sizes specific to web sites:

1. In your browser menu click “Tools”
2. Click “Internet Options”
3. Click the “Accessibility” button
4. Place a check mark next to “Ignore font sizes specified on Web pages”
